Traveller's Journey

Exemption from Quarantine (TEST & GO)

First phase start on 1 November 2021



Before arrival

- Travel by air from the approved countries/territories where travellers must have stayed for 21 days or more. (except Thais and foreign residents).

Documentation:

- A Certificate of Vaccination (fully vaccinated) with an approved vaccine at least 14 days before travel.



- Those previously infected within 3 months must have received 1 dose of an approved vaccine at least 14 days before travel and a medical certificate of recovery.

- Travellers under **12 years of age**, travelling with parents, are exempt from the vaccination requirement.

- A Medical Certificate with an **RT-PCR lab result** indicating that COVID-19 is not detected issued **no more than 72 hours** before travel. (all travellers)

- A confirmed payment for 1-night stay at SHA+, AQ, OQ, or AHQ, and 1 RT-PCR test.

- An insurance policy with coverage no less than US\$50,000.



When you're leaving

11 Free to go anywhere in Thailand or leave Thailand to other countries. However, travellers are advised to follow the guidelines and measures announced by the respective country of their destination.

Traveller's Journey: Living in The "Blue Zone"

17 Sandbox Destinations, First Phase start on 1 November, 2021

Before Arrival

- Travel by air from any country around the world.

Documentation:

- A Certificate of Vaccination (fully vaccinated) with an approved vaccine at least 14 days before travel.
- Those previously infected within 3 months must have received 1 dose of an approved vaccine at least 14 days before travel and a medical certificate of recovery.
- Travellers under **18 years of age**, travelling with parents, are exempt from the vaccination requirement.
- A Medical Certificate with an **RT-PCR lab result** indicating that COVID-19 is not detected issued **no more than 72 hours** before travel. **(all travellers)**
- A confirmed payment for an accommodation at **SHA+ and RT-PCR test**.
- An insurance policy with coverage no less than US\$50,000.

2 Wait for an approval of Vaccine Certification and paid-accommodation incl. RT-PCR

3 Confirmation of Approval, receive Thailand Pass QR Code.



During your stay



9 Stay at least first 7 nights within one of the 17 Blue Zone Sandbox destinations, if planning to continue the journey to other destinations in Thailand.

10 If staying less than 7 nights, must leave Thailand immediately on a direct flight to another country.
*All travellers are subject to two required COVID-19 tests: the first test upon arrival by an RT-PCR method, and *the second test on Day 6-7 by self-testing ATK.
***effective on 1 Nov. 2021 onwards.**

11 Practice the D-M-H-T-T-A* precautions.

12 After having completed a seven-night stay in one of the 17 Blue Zone destinations, free to go anywhere in Thailand or leave Thailand to other countries. However, travellers are advised to follow the guidelines and measures announced by the respective province/country of their destination.

Arrival



4 Present the Thailand Pass QR Code to the Health Control to carry out checks, then proceed through Immigration procedures.

5 Undergo the RT-PCR COVID-19 test at the reserved accommodation, or the pre-arranged test centre. (Children aged under 6 have saliva test.)

6 Proceed to the hotel by the pre-arranged airport transfer. **(Distance from airport within 5 hours)**

7 Download and install the **MorChana** App. at the hotel.

8 Wait for the test result within the hotel room.



Traveller's Journey: Alternative Quarantine (AQ) Happy Quarantine Nationwide Start on 1 November, 2021



Before Arrival

- Travel from any country around the world.
- **If fully vaccinated, 7-day quarantine.**
- **If unvaccinated or partially vaccinated,** 10-day quarantine for air and sea arrivals and 14-day quarantine for land arrivals.

Documentation:

- A Medical Certificate with an **RT-PCR lab result** indicating that COVID-19 is not detected issued **no more than 72 hours** before travel. **(all travellers)**
- **A confirmed payment for an AQ accommodation.**
- **An insurance policy** with coverage no less than US\$50,000.

2 Wait for an approval of Vaccine Certification and paid-accommodation incl. RT-PCR



3 Confirmation of **Approval**, receive **Thailand Pass QR Code**



During your stay

9 **Must complete the required quarantine period** if planning to continue the journey to other destinations in Thailand.

- For fully vaccinated travellers, 7-day quarantine is required. (RT-PCR test on the first day and Day 6-7).
- For unvaccinated or partially vaccinated travellers;
 - For air and sea arrivals, 10-day quarantine. (RT-PCR test on the first day and Day 8-9)
 - For land arrivals, 14-day quarantine (RT-PCR test on the first day and Day 12-13).

10 Practice the D-M-H-T-T-A* precautions.

When you're leaving



11 After having completed a quarantine period, free to go anywhere in Thailand or leave Thailand to other countries. However, travellers are advised to follow the guidelines and measures announced by the respective province/country of their destination.



Arrival



4 Present the Thailand Pass QR Code to the Health Control to carry out checks, then proceed through Immigration procedures.

5 Undergo the RT-PCR COVID-19 test at the reserved accommodation, or the pre-arranged test centre. (Children aged under 6 have saliva test.)

6 Proceed to the hotel by the pre-arranged airport transfer. **(Distance from airport within 2 hours)**

7 **Download and install an alert application.**

8 Wait for the test result within the hotel room. If testing negative for COVID-19, travellers can enjoy activities within the designated areas of the accommodation.
